SKIP HIRE TERMS & CONDITIONS

- All skips must be level loaded. Skips are subject to an overloaded charge of £100 if they exceed the fill line
- The customer must ensure that the skip is sited on private property that has the permission of the landowner. The customer must notify Atlantic Recycling if the skip is not on private property and requires a permit.
- The placing of skips/vehicles on block paved, slabbed or tarmacked driveways, or soft and unlevel ground is done so at the express request of the customer.
- Atlantic Recycling take no responsibility for damage caused at the customers premises when being directed to deliver/ collect a skip off road by the customer.
- Atlantic Recycling will not accept liability for damage caused to manholes, ducting, cabling or overhead/underground utilities that are damaged during the act of delivering/ collecting the skip
- No electrical items are permitted in the skips including fridges/freezers; other contraband items include tyres, asbestos and gas bottles.
- No plasterboard to go into the skip unless this is agreed and paid for at time of booking. Plasterboard is subject to extra charges if found in the skip.
- All accepted orders for skips imply the customers agreement to our terms and conditions of sale
